Everything You Need to Know About Christmas Village 2022

Christmas Village will light up the Ogden Municipal Gardens (353 E 25th Street) beginning November 26, 2022, after the Holiday Electric Light Parade.

The Village: Cottages sponsored and created by the community will turn historic downtown into a nightly vision of Santa's village at the North Pole, from 5:00 p.m. until midnight. The theme for Christmas Village festivities this year is "Shine Bright," and an ornament in the shape of a diamond is hidden in each of the cottages for visitors to find as they explore the displays. Visitors to the village can also vote for their favorite cottage at christmasvillage.ogdencity.com.

The Santa Run, Holiday Electric Light Parade, and Christmas Village Opening Gala: The Santa Run, a 5k run before the parade where all participants dress as Santa Claus, will begin at 4:30 p.m. near 22nd and Washington Blvd. The Santa Runners will travel the opposite side of traffic, run south to 28th Street, and then return to 22nd street to finally make their jolly finish on 25th street.

The Holiday Electric Light Parade will promptly start at 5:30 p.m., lighting up the parade route beginning on 22nd Street and heading south along Washington Boulevard to 27th Street. The Christmas Village opening ceremony begins when the parade reaches the Municipal Gardens, and people gather in the Ogden amphitheater at approximately 6:30 p.m. The Mayor of Christmas Village, Rick Danger, General Manager of proud community supporter Admiral Beverage, will be recognized, and parade awards will be given. Thanks to the Make-A-Wish Foundation, Santa Claus will make an appearance, accompanied by the Grand Marshal of the Parade. After they both turn on the lights illuminating another holiday season downtown, a firework show will conclude the gala.

Entertainment and Activities: Live entertainment and activities will be featured for visitors at Christmas Village until December 23, 2022. Interested performers can email amphitheater@ogdencity.com starting October 1.

Santa will greet children in his castle Monday through Friday from 6:00 p.m. until 9:00 p.m. and Saturdays from 5:00 p.m. until 9:00 p.m., November 26 until December 23.

Other activities at Christmas Village include The Mini Polar Express Train, and concessions will be available at the hot chocolate booth s well as The Corner.

Breakfast with Santa: A Breakfast with Santa event will be hosted at the Ogden Union Station on December 10, 2022. Reservations are required to attend the event and can be made at christmasvillage.ogdencity.com.

Reservations can be made for preschool groups to tour Christmas Village with Mrs. Santa during daytime hours by calling 801-629-8714.

Support Christmas Village: "Santa's Store" is located at the north entrance to Christmas Village and features gifts and souvenirs to help commemorate and share the Christmas Village spirit. Proceeds from the sale of Christmas Village items fund new lights and displays for years to come. Official 2022 Christmas Village Sweatshirts are available for purchase, ranging in price from \$20 to \$30.

Crosswalk Safety

School Crosswalks

- Come to a complete stop before the crosswalk
- Stay stopped until the pedestrian(s) are out of the crosswalk and onto the sidewalk
- A crossing guard does not need to be present for rules to apply
- Rules apply to all crosswalks with designated school crossing signs (not just school zones)
- Do not pass a car that is stopped at the crosswalk
Rules apply to all crosswalks with designated school crossing signs (not just school zones).

Regular Crosswalks

- Come to a complete stop before the crosswalk
- Stay stopped until the pedestrian(s) are no longer on your side of the roadway
- Do not pass a car that is already stopped at a crosswalk
- If there are light indicators, follow the posted signs and lights
- If there are flashing Red Lights, treat the area as a Stop Sign, come up to the solid line, stop, then proceed if clear.

Ogden Awarded for Weber River Project

Ogden City Engineers recognized at the 2022 Utah Outdoor Summit Awards for Grant Project of the Year

This project on the Weber River is located near the Stockyards on Exchange Road just west of the 24th Street Viaduct at the Kayak Park location.

Work done there included installation of a safe play area for kids, ADA access from the bowery to the river, a fish passage channel, and 3 drops for kayaking. The work also addressed problematic velocities/flows, bank work that helps oxygenate water, increasing plant growth mitigating non-point source pollution, as well as a sewer line improvement.

September 19, 2022, marked the 50th anniversary of the Clean Water Act. Ogden City is unique in the fact that we are home to the confluence of two rivers and our engineering team works diligently to maintain and improve these areas for the benefit of our community.



Emergency Preparedness: Flu Season
